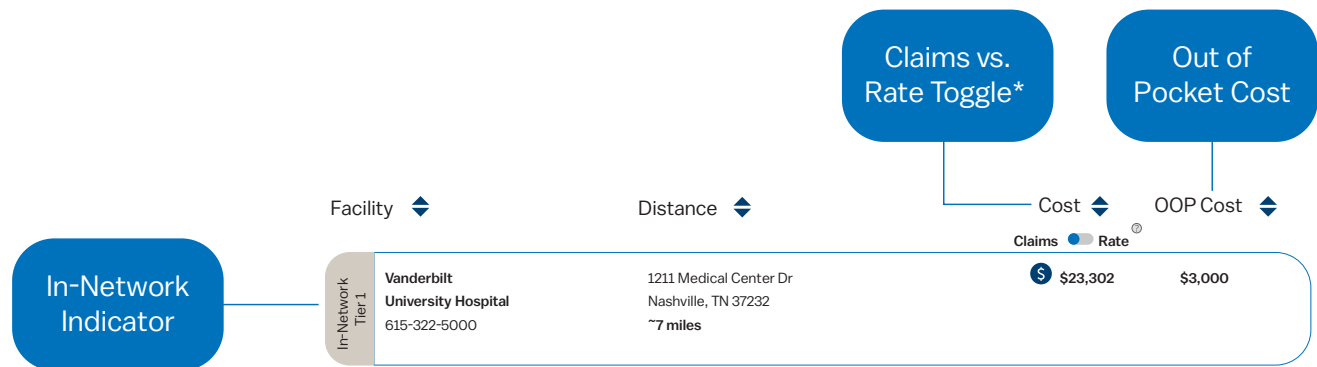

Out of Pocket Balances:

*Claims – the historical amount paid to the providers for the selected service plus common related services.

Rate – the reported negotiated rate between your health plan and the provider for the selected service. This is the amount that your health plan or health insurance issuer has contractually agreed to pay this provider for the covered item or service
