From diagnosis, to treatment, to release from medical care, each patient enrolled has a dedicated oncology case manager who:



Provides disease-specific educational resources to help manage the side effects of treatment



Helps coordinate care, working collaboratively with treating providers



Confirms that treatments align with health benefits plan



Helps find copay and financial assistance when needed



Helps facilitate second opinions

Frequently Asked Questions

Who qualifies for the program?

If you are a member of your employer's health benefit plan, have a positive cancer diagnosis, and are actively receiving treatment, you are qualified to participate in the program.

How and when do I enroll in the program?

You can enroll by calling **800.983.1590**.

The program's case managers can assist you and your family at any time during your treatment. We recommend enrolling immediately following diagnosis so your oncology case manager can assist you and your family through every step of the journey.

We know a new cancer diagnosis is stressful, so if you forget to enroll after diagnosis, an oncology case manager may contact you. You can choose to opt-in to the program at that time.

What happens after I enroll?

Once you're enrolled, your dedicated oncology case manager will provide clinical and emotional support for you and your family through ongoing care assessment calls. He or she will also be a resource for financial assistance if necessary.

How does this affect the care I receive from my primary care doctor or oncologist?

The Oncology Care Integration program does not interfere with your regular care, and it does not replace the care you receive from your regular physicians. Your case manager interacts with your physician's office and maintains close communication with them throughout your enrollment in the program.

How long can I be in the program?

You will be enrolled in the program as long as you are going through treatment and continue to be a member of the health benefits plan that provides the program. Patients are discharged from the program if they opt out.
