


AI Isn't Coming - It's Already Here.



The AI Intake Process (For Bigger Ideas)





What You Can Do Today


M365 Copilot is ready to be used. You can use it today on the web, or in Word, Outlook, Teams, Excel, and PowerPoint.

Start with your own meetings, emails, reports









The Problem We All Know



This is what leadership looks like on a Tuesday



Copilot's First Try (Basic Prompt)

Live demo:

“Summarize this meeting and email thread”

Result:

This is a start... but not leadership-grade





The **quality of the output** depends on the **clarity of the input**.

Using the meeting recap, related email threads, and any referenced documents:

Create an executive-level action summary that includes:

- A concise overview of the topic or discussion
- Key decisions that were made
- Open questions or unresolved items
- Action items with owners and suggested next steps
- Any risks, blockers, or dependencies leaders should be aware of

Then draft a short, professional follow-up email I can send to stakeholders that:

- Summarizes the outcome
- Highlights next steps
- Clearly communicates accountability

Use a clear, neutral tone appropriate for senior leadership.

The Power of the Prompt





Leverage

The clearer you are, the **more value** you get back.

30 secs of clarity →
30 mins of output



Repeatable

A strong prompt is **reusable**. You build it once, then use it repeatedly. It also has a Goal, Source, Context, and Format.



Teachable

Prompts are teachable. Once you master a good one, you can **coach your team** (and peers) to use it too.

Your guidance determines AI value.

This is how we lead with AI, not just use it.






From Prompt to Practice

Make AI part of your workflow, not an event. Build the **habits** that build **momentum**. The more you use it, the more **valuable** it becomes

Responsible Use - AI Gone Wrong




Short Story

Copilot made a wrong assumption. (“Hallucination”)



Why It Happened

Vague Input.
No Review.



What We Do

Clear Prompts.
Review Outputs.
Own Final Product.

**Copilot Assists.
You Decide.**

Copilot is **confident**. Even when it’s wrong. It tries to be helpful, **not necessarily correct**, which is why **your judgment always matters**.
