

A Client's Guide To Registering on myOhioHealthy.com




To register as a client on myOhioHealthy.com for the first time, you will need to follow these steps:

Step One: Create an Account

Go to myOhioHealthy.com and select the Create Your Account button under the Employer/Client section.

Each client user will need to create their own account.




Step Two: Account Creation

- a. Check the box before "I'm not a robot."
- b. Click Next.



Step Three: Create an Account


- a. Enter a username and password. The system will tell you immediately if the username has already been taken. Usernames must be four or more characters and contain at least one non-alpha character (not including an *, &, %, (), = or +sign). Passwords are case-sensitive and must be 6 to 32 characters long with at least one non-alpha character.
- b. Enter your *name* and *e-mail address* that you want to use to recover your username, in the event you forget it.
- c. Select and answer three security questions.
- d. Select the *Submit* button.



Note: If at any time, you forget your username or password, you can select the appropriate link under the login button on the home page, and then follow the prompts.


Step Four: Confirm Account Creation

Re-enter the password you created to confirm your account creation. Select the Next button.



Step Five: Enter code

- a. Enter the first 5 digits of your 6-digit Group Number as provided by OhioHealthy
- b. Click "Next" to continue



Step Six: Complete Registration

The OhioHealthy Onboarding Team will get a confirmation and then assign permissions and activate the account.

You will receive an email notification that there is a message waiting for you in the **Message Center**. The message will confirm your account has been activated.

Do NOT login until you receive the activation message.
